Maths	<p>N - Numbers Doubling Can you sing our doubling song? '1 + 1 = 2, tap it on your shoe, 2 + 2 = 4, stamp it on the floor, 3 + 3 = 6, do some finger clicks, 4 + 4 = 8, put your arms up straight, 5 + 5 = 10, let's do it all again! Get an adult to shout out the sums and then see if you can write down the answers - how fast can you write them?</p>	<p>SSM Sing along to this 3D shape song that we often sing at school. Can you remember these 3D shapes? Cuboid Cuboids have four rectangular faces and two square faces. How many cuboids can you find at home? See if you can have a little competition with someone at home to see who can find the most!</p>	<p>SSM Let's Measure! Can you create some buns/biscuits to share with your family? See if you can work with an adult and help to weigh out the ingredients carefully. Make sure you read the scales properly and try not to put too much or too little in the bowl.</p> 	<p>N - Numbers Sharing Numbers Can you draw two large ice cream cones like these below? Roll a dice to see which number you land on? Using small objects as toppings, see if you can share out the number of toppings equally between the two cones. You could share out different toppings and create delicious looking ice creams. Yummy!</p> 	<p>N - Numbers / Doubles Songs Song 1 Song 2 How many doubles can you think of? See if you can write them down and check to see if you are right!</p>  <p>3 + 3 = 6</p>
Phonics, Reading and Writing	<p>Phonics Sounds of the week y/Y - Recap Phase 3 sounds Watch: - Geraldine Giraffe repeating the phoneme 'y'. Play: - Buried Treasure and see if you can read the words that include the 'y' phoneme in them. Can you write a list of other words that you can think of that have the 'y' sound in them?</p>	<p>Phonics Sounds of the week z/Z - Recap Phase 3 sounds Watch: - Geraldine Giraffe repeating the phoneme 'z'. Play: - Pick a Picture and have a go at reading the word and matching it to the correct picture. Can you try to write a simple sentence to include a word that has the 'z' phoneme in? E.g. 'I can zip up my coat'</p>	<p>R - Reading Listen to the story 'Sharing a Shell' by Julia Donaldson. Talk about the story together. Discuss what happened. Can you spot how many words you can find in the book that have the 'sh' phoneme in them? Have a go at trying to segment the sounds and blend them together to read the words. Sometimes sounds can be found at the beginning, middle or end of a word.</p>	<p>W - Writing Make a list of animals/plants that you might find in seaside habitats. How many different types of creatures can you find there? (Ideas could include: beach, rock pools, ocean)</p> 	<p>R - Beach Den See if you can make a beach hideout at home! You can use any materials you wish to create a beach hut/den to sit in the wonderful sunshine, listening to the waves and snuggling up with a wonderful book. Don't forget a towel!</p> 
Other Activities	<p>EAD - Music Time Can you create your own musical instrument? Think about how you would play your instrument? Does it have a loud/quiet sound? You could create your instrument to sound like waves in the sea.</p>	<p>UTW Investigation Time Can you create a boat using empty containers or materials you may have at home? Does it float? How many 10p pieces can you place in it before it sinks? Test it out to see!</p> 	<p>CL - Talking Together Have a chat with someone in your family and think about people who help you. What do they do? What can you do to help them? You could draw a person who may help you at school or at home and label or even write a sentence about them.</p>	<p>PD - Keep on Moving! Wild Workouts Can you complete these wild workouts with Andy from CBeebies? Have fun! The Beach Under the Sea</p>	<p>EAD - Let's Be Creative! Can you design (and build) a new home for the three creatures to share? You could use cardboard boxes, plastic tubs, shoe boxes and any other materials you may have at home.</p>
