# F2 Home Learning Ideas

## Phonics - 's' and 'a'

Last week, the children did a super job at learning the sounds for the letters 's' and 'a'.

Click here to listen to the Jolly Phonics songs. Can you sing the song and make the action? Play 'I Spy'! How many things can you find that start with 's' and 'a'? Post your results on Tapestry and see if you can beat your teacher!

#### Listening - Go on a sound hunt!

What sounds can you hear in your house or outside?
Can you draw pictures of what you can hear?
Can you make different sounds using the pots and pans in your kitchen? What makes the loudest sound? What makes the quietest sound?

## Music - Singing

- © Can you sing 'If you're happy and you know it'? Can you make all the actions? Can you sing it even faster?
- Think of your favourite song we sing at school and perform it for an adult.

## Maths - Counting

Can you count to 10? Can you do 5 star jumps? Can you clap 7 times? What numbers can you see around your house or during a walk? You could look at door numbers, number plates, on food packets, clocks or in books. You could take photos or draw pictures of the numbers you find.

# Writing - Name writing

Practise writing your name. Can you use your finger to write it in shampoo/shaving foam? Can you use pasta/stones/sticks to make the letters in your name? Can you use a pencil/pen/coloured crayons to write your name? Can you use your finger to write your name in the sky?

## Maths - Shape

Can you go on a shape hunt and find a circle/square/triangle and rectangle? When you are having a meal count how many different shapes you can find. What shapes are on your plate?

#### Creative

Can you draw faces that show different emotions? Can you draw a happy face? Can you draw an angry face? Use a mirror to see how you can make your face look angry/happy/sad/calm etc.

Can you take photographs of your family making different faces?

Can you find items in nature that are the colours from the story?
