Safeguarding corner – Dealing with issues



Telling the school and/or telling family members when there are issues

This week in safeguarding corner we would like to re-iterate one of the key messages given to the children which is all around the importance of telling the school or at least telling family members when issue arise so that we can have the very best chance of helping quickly and preventing any of the smaller issues becoming bigger issues.

We advise children to consider:

- Telling a trusted adult in the building, which may be their favourite teacher or anyone in the safeguarding team
- Telling a family member who can then tell the school either by phone or email.

Often in school, when investigating an issue it almost always comes to light that the matter started with a small issue which became bigger because it was not flagged up to anybody earlier. The school will work tirelessly to support the children BUT we can only help somebody with something IF we have been told it is an issue. We really appreciate your help in letting us know of issues as soon as they arise.
