Attendance

Attendance continues to be a high priority this year and we will be promoting good attendance at every opportunity. If children miss days of school then it can have an extremely negative impact on their learning. No school means no learning!

Please ensure your children attend each day they are well enough and avoid taking children out of school for holidays.
