PSHCE Curriculum

In the next set of newsletters we would like to explain to you all a bit more about our PSHE curriculum. PSHE stands for Personal, Social and Health Education.

The scheme we use to enhance our learning in school is known as the Jigsaw Scheme of work. The aim of Jigsaw is to support children to feel a strong sense of belonging and community by taking part in whole school assemblies, end of work outcomes, displays and bring the learning alive through weekly celebrations to make it lived across the school community and in children's lives outside of school.
